.... is a cross-border joint venture of local and regional authorities in the border region (grensregio) where Germany, the Netherlands and Belgium come together. The partners are the city regions of Parkstad Limburg and Aachen, the municipalities of Aachen, Heerlen and Vaals, and the German-speaking community of Belgium.

.... has the following objectives:

boosting the economic development of the entire region that includes more than 800,000 inhabitants, simplifying cross-border working and living, and improving coordination between policy plans and developments in the region.

.... and wishes:

via cross-border cooperation and in consultation with other partners, to provide job seekers with an overview of the entire range of jobs, traineeships and courses on offer in the border region, to make it easier for businesses to find suitable staff, to encourage the extension of the cross-border public transport network and to make it more accessible, and to inform one another at an early stage about policy plans and regional developments and to coordinate them where necessary.

.... has:

a board, consisting of the chairs of both city regions, the mayors of the municipalities of Aachen, Heerlen and Vaals, a mayor from the urban region of Aachen, and the Minister-President and two mayors on behalf of the German-speaking community of Belgium, and an official working group in which all partners are represented and which focuses on the themes and the project agenda.
